MIDDLE EAST CONFLICT - MARKET ANNOUNCEMENT

Dear Valued Customer,

We wish to advise you of an upcoming adjustment to our List Prices, effective 1st April 2026, in response to the Middle East Conflict and the direct impact on the landed cost of globally sourced raw materials.

Significant daily cost increases are already observed across non-metal components of our products: Oil based PVC and XLPE materials, local & international freight and metal processing costs. Aluminium LME has also risen sharply since February impacted by a production cap in China, pressuring global supply. We are seeing substantial inflation continuing to impact energy, freight, timber and labour costs, moreover these factors are disrupting supply chains with lead times increasing.

As always, Nexans uses its global purchasing power and procurement expertise to provide the best possible value to its customers while ensuring stable and reliable availability of supply. Despite our efforts and expertise, these global factors are beyond the control of Nexans.

Effective 1st April 2026, our price lists will increase by between 2% to 5%, depending on cable type and the content of non-metal cost components. Updated price files will be circulated to our partners and customers in the coming days.

Existing orders will be supplied under current agreed arrangements. New orders are being monitored and processed based on quotations and agreed volumes. Nexans reserves the right to review and mutually agree volumes with customers on a case by case basis.
